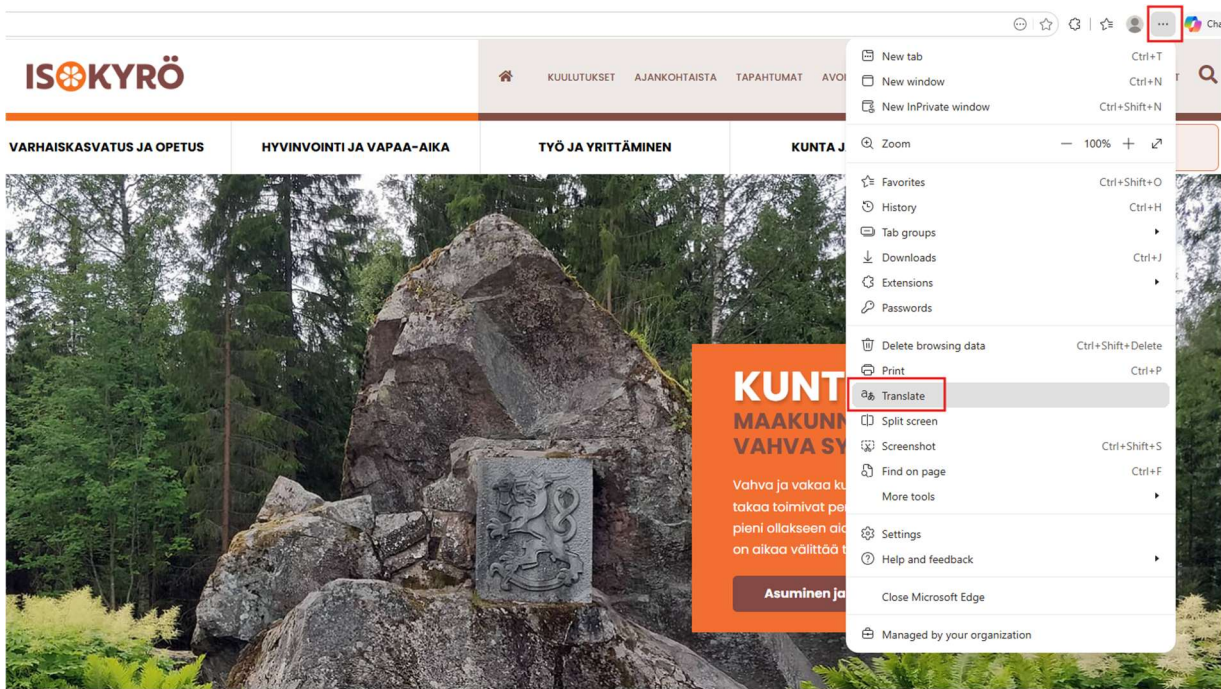


Changing the language of a page

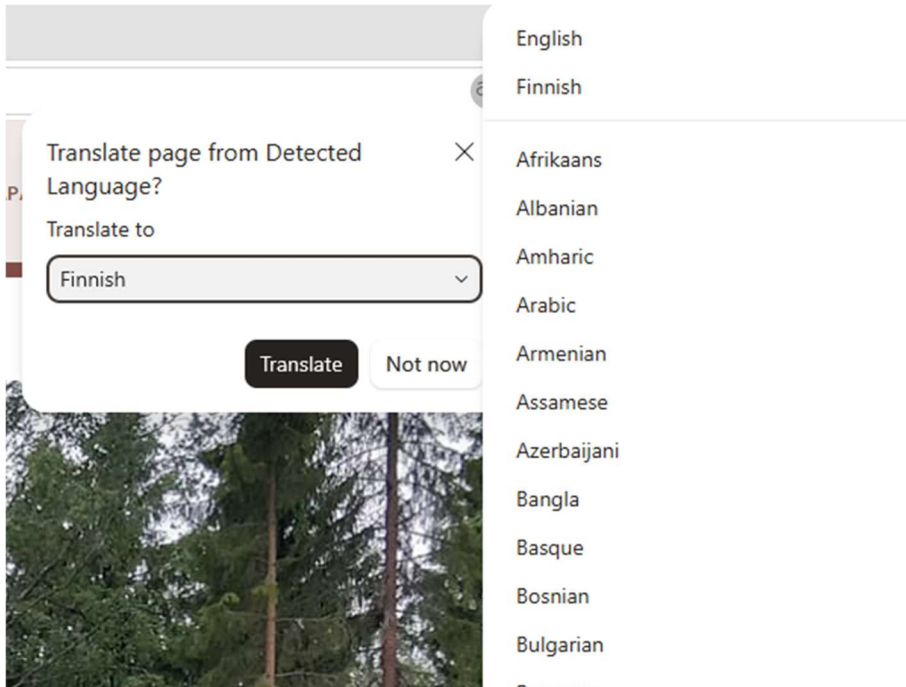
You can change the language of the page in your browser's settings. Below are instructions for changing the language in different browsers.

Microsoft Edge

Go to the page you want to switch to another language. Select 3 dots at the top right. Select translate.

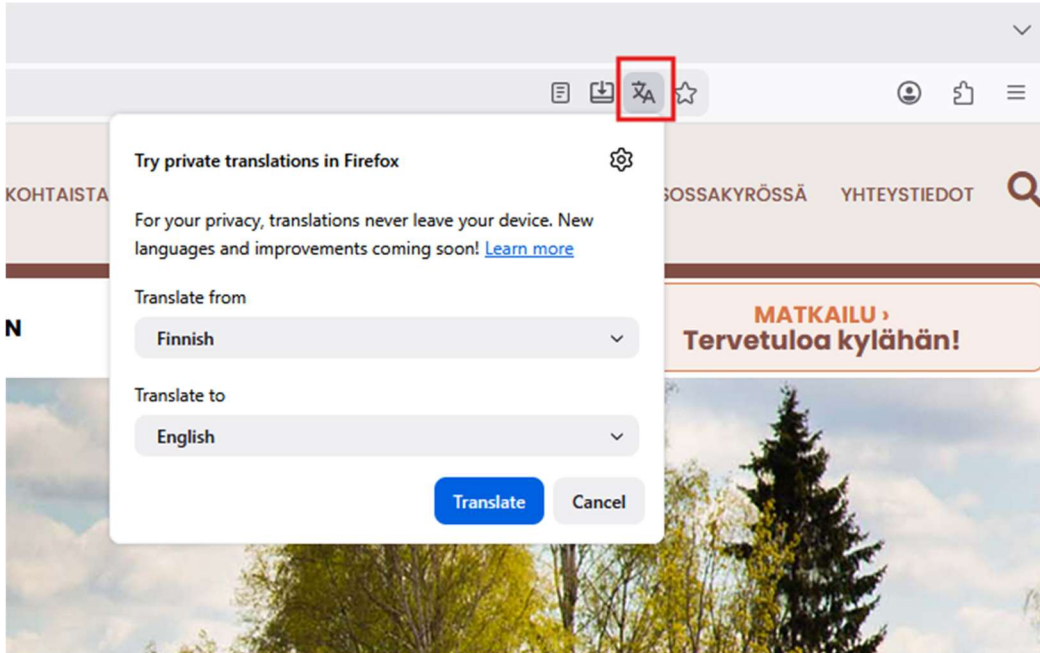


Select the language you want to translate the page into. Then press translate.

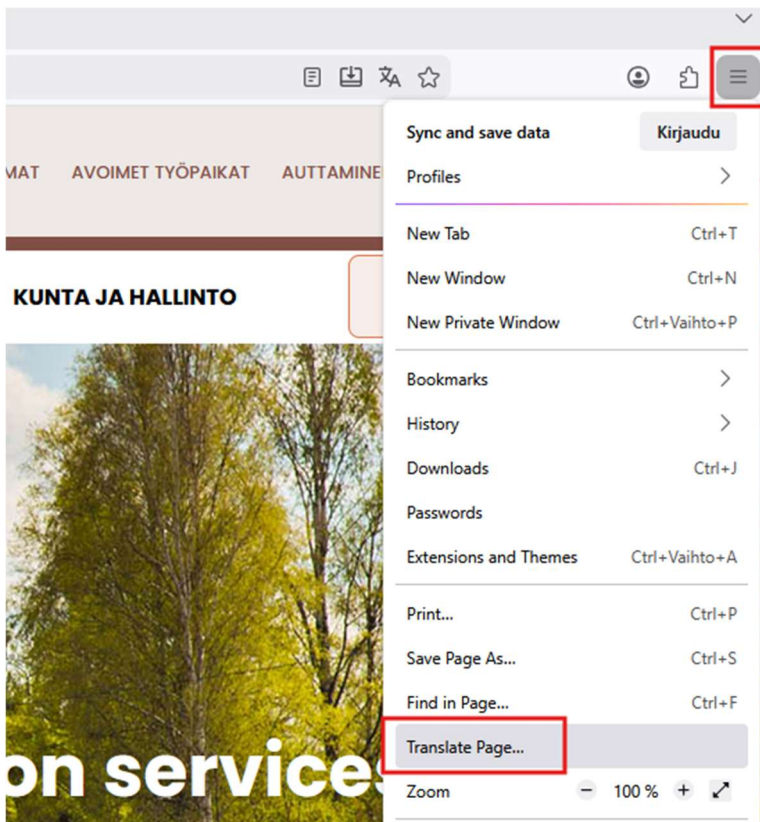


Firefox

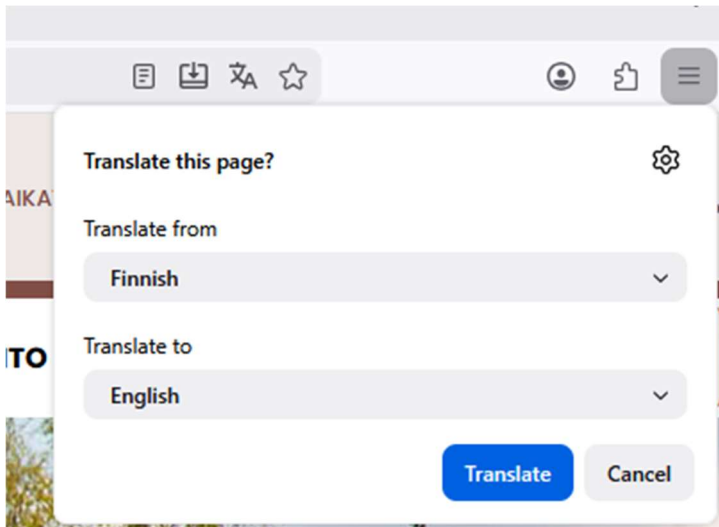
Go to the page you want to switch to another language. There are two ways to translate a language in Firefox. You can select the icon after the address bar (pictured below). Select the language you want to change from (Finnish) and to which language. Press translate.



Alternatively, you can select the 3 lines in the top right corner of the page and select "Translate Page...".



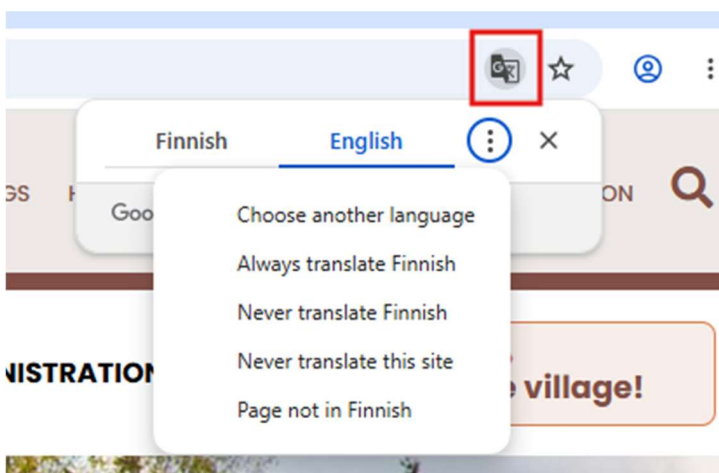
Again, select the language from which you want to change (Finnish) and to which language. Press translate.



Google Chrome

Go to the page you want to switch to another language. There are two ways to translate a language in Google Chrome.

You can select the icon after the address bar (pictured below). If you see the language you want to change to, select it. Or select the 3 dots and then "Choose another language".



Choose language and press "Done".
